In February, my colleague and I traveled to the Northern part of Cameroon to construct 4 tabernacles in Ngaoundere, Garoua, Gaschiga, and Mora. In the extreme north, we had to be accompanied by two Special Forces' soldiers because of the activity of the terrorist group Boku Haram who have sought to harm Christians, churches and missionaries working in the area. We traveled hundreds of miles. Some of the roads were in such poor condition that we could only drive 10 or so miles an hour. Despite these challenges, the trip was an overwhelming success.

Pastor Ayim, leader of the Gaschiga congregation said, "I am very content to see the tabernacle in Gaschiga- My joy is overflowing. May the Lord be glorified, and may He bless the brothers and sisters who have brought the tabernacle. May they be filled with joy as they advance his work."
